


## Statement by our Presidential Candidate:

*I am a Native American, deprived of my language, culture, and traditions; yet, I have survived the genocidal government policies against Indigenous Peoples. I will ensure equal rights to liberty, education, employment, housing, and health care, regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, religion, or sexual orientation. I will work towards conflict resolution without the use of violence and ensure self-determination for all peoples.*

*I live with injustice every day. Caged for over 28 years for a crime I did not commit, I am a political prisoner wrongfully convicted by a government that indisputably withheld and fabricated evidence, as well as coerced witnesses. No branch of the government will correct this injustice. At the root of this injustice are the oppressive policies of the U.S. government against people of color and those with dissenting opinions. I pledge to eliminate such policies. I will abolish the federal death penalty and restore the constitutional protections which ensure justice for all people.*

*Our environment is the essence of our life, but our government – in partnership with greedy corporations – haphazardly destroys it for the monetary benefit of a few. I will protect our environment to ensure our survival and the survival of our future generations.*

*If elected, my top three priorities will be:*

- *Abolish the federal death penalty and release all political prisoners.*
- *Make the government abide by all its treaties with Native Americans and other nations.*
- *Remove all U.S. troops from other countries such as Iraq and Afghanistan.*

## ALL MY RELATIONS- LEONARD PELTIER

Leonard Peltier is a citizen of the Lakota (Sioux) and Anishinabe (Chippewa) nations. He was a leading activist in the American Indian Movement (AIM), which engaged in a prolonged struggle with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the FBI during the 1960s and 1970s. In 1975 an armed clash between AIM members and FBI agents resulted in the deaths of two agents. Even though **the U.S. government openly admits that they do not know who killed the FBI agents**, Peltier was convicted of the murders and remains in prison 28 years later.

Amnesty International considers Leonard Peltier to be a political prisoner calling for his immediate and unconditional release. Many throughout the international community have also called for his release including Nelson Mandela, Rigoberta Menchu Tum, the Dalai Lama, Archbishop Desmond Tutu, Coretta Scott King, Angela Davis, and Robert Redford.

## Statement by our Vice-Presidential candidate, Janice Jordan:

*I am honored to be the Vice-Presidential candidate of the Peace and Freedom Party of California, the most populous state in the United States. I am also humbled to be campaigning with Nobel Peace Prize Nominee Leonard Peltier. I have lived in California all my life, and from a very young age I have been active in social justice, human services and environmental issues.*

*The current situation of international violence and occupation could have been avoided through dialogue and diplomacy, approaches that Leonard Peltier and I take pride in as social justice and human rights advocates. There is only one political party in power (the Republicans and the Democrats) in the United States, and unfortunately diplomacy, justice, civil rights and human rights take a backstage to unregulated military spending, unchecked human rights violations and criminal police behavior. The United States has not made itself into a leader in democracy or freedom; it has alienated itself from the rest of the world and from many of its own people.*

*Over the years, I have worked to end the disproportionate incarceration of poor people and people of color; the rise of homelessness among women, men, children and families (especially veterans); rampant military spending; police brutality; and the environmental destruction of reservations. I continue to advocate for low-cost housing, livable wages, free speech, free healthcare, access to higher education, social security safety for seniors, same-sex marriage rights, and medical marijuana. Government policies that benefit the working class and working poor should be a priority not a problem. Healthcare, education, employment and a livable wage are basic human rights, not privileges.*

*One or two people cannot cure the ills created by centuries of abuse and neglect. However, Leonard Peltier and I will listen to communities that have been overlooked and ignored, and we will advocate for the right of each and every person to live a healthy, productive and safe life in the richest country in the world. As the only socialist and feminist party with ballot status in California, the Peace and Freedom Party offers an opportunity to voice these concerns. Working for effective change will happen by voting your conscience, not your fear.*
